Procedural Order Number Two

The Parties and the Arbitrator participated in a Conference by telephone on
December 29, 2009. Present on the call were Arbitrator William Baker; Case Manager
Sara Isom on behalf of the American Arbitration Association; Jilian Estes and Jonathan
Cohen on behalf of Claimants; and Peter Homer on behalf of Respondents.

Based on the briefs submitted by the Parties and the discussion on the call, it is
hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Arbitrator will stay the issuance of a Clause Construction Award until a ruling by
the U.S. Supreme Court in the case of *Stolt-Nielsen S.A., et al. v. Animalfeeds
International Corp.*, Docket No. 08-1198, or until the end of the current Supreme Court
Term in June of 2010, whichever shall first occur.

2. If the Supreme Court issues a ruling in the *Stolt-Neilsen* case before the end of its current term, and if either party wishes a further telephone conference with the Arbitrator before he issues his Clause Construction Award, such party shall promptly notify the AAA of its wish for a further conference call.

3. In the meantime, Claimants may proceed with individual discovery, but not class discovery, regarding Respondents' dealings with the named Claimants. Such discovery shall be narrow in scope. If there is any dispute about the scope of discovery, either party may request a further telephone conference with the arbitrator.
